IACCP Culture & Psychology Summer School

July $28^{th} - 31^{st} 2023$



Overview

The Culture & Psychology (C&P) School is the educational wing of the International Association for Cross-Cultural Psychology (IACCP). The School has a workshop format and is open to students at Doctoral and Masters' levels who are interested in culture and psychology. Workshops are geared toward students of varying levels, from early to advanced graduate studies. The C&P School provides a research-intensive and interactive experience for participants to receive specialized training from experts in the field of psychology and culture. It also provides a stimulating environment for students to learn from each other.

The C&P School supports the development of broad research skills, international collaborations, and the preparation of scholarly manuscripts. We aim to stimulate networking and interactions with peers and instructors in a nurturing and productive environment. We also aim to emphasize the importance of the applied character of research and the necessity of interdisciplinary collaborations.

The C&P School will take place July 28th to July 31st., 2023 This will directly precede the 2023 International Congress of the IACCP in Limerick, Ireland, July 31st – August 5th, 2023 (https://iaccp2023.com/).

The program

In 2023, The C&P School has an in-person format. Students can choose two content streams from four streams as listed below. Instructors are required to prepare 7 hours of teaching content, discussion, and activities daily for two and a half days. There will be group activities consisting of all students for half a day.

The workshops will include an afternoon class on July 28th and will continue all day on July 29th and July 30th. The program concludes with a morning class on July 31st before the conference opening ceremony in the evening.

Morning classes start 8:30 am to 12:30 pm and afternoon classes start 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm. There is lunch between 12:30 pm to 2:00 pm and coffee breaks in the morning and afternoon.

Instructors are encouraged to submit proposals to the following stream areas. Please note that these are some examples of the streams that the C&P Committee has developed *(modifications with justifications are welcomed).*

STREAM 1 - Methodological Statistical Stream- Mixed methods

STREAM 2 - non-WEIRD/ Western approaches to Cross-Cultural Psychology

STREAM 3 - Cross-Cultural Health Psychology

STREAM 4 - Collective action and social change in cross-cultural settings OR indigenous psychology

March 20, 2023: Deadline for Instructor applications

March 30, 2023: Decision notification

Benefits

The C&P School pays \$800 honorarium for each stream, covers the cost of accommodation for three nights, and pays for registration for the IACCP congress (early bird member rate). If there are two instructors for one stream, the honorarium will be divided, and half of the cost of early bird conference registration will be covered for each of the two instructors. Accommodation will be negotiated accordingly if there is more than one instructor for one stream.

Application Materials

Please send a cover letter describing your stream, why you wish to teach in the C&P School, and your curriculum vitae to *cultureandpsychologyschool@gmail.com*.

Instructors are encouraged in their application to define their topic and their teaching approach clearly and describe how it relates to one of the four streams.

It is also encouraged to outline students' learning outcomes and the rationale for teaching in the C&P School.
